
A Cross for the Ages

Christ Jubilee 2025 Inaugurated

The diocesan-level inauguration of Christ Jubilee 2025 took place simultaneously at three pilgrim centers on 29 December 2024 at 8:00 am. Rev. Bishop presided over the ceremony at St. George Shrine Church, Munchirai, while Rev. Fr. Thomas Powathuparampil, the Vicar General, was the main celebrant at Holy Cross Shrine Church, Malaicode, and Rev. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal at St. Alphonsa Shrine Church, Nagercoil. The

inaugural liturgical ceremony commenced at a designated location where the newly prepared Jubilee Cross was blessed. In a solemn procession, the faithful carried the cross to the respective Shrine Churches. The Jubilee Candle was then lit, symbolizing the start of the Jubilee Year, followed by the Solemn Holy Qurbana. The liturgy concluded with the recitation of the Jubilee Prayer and Jubilee Song.






Celebrating Christmas Eve Together

A Synodal Path

Priests' Conference at Sangamam

A special Priests' Conference was held at Sangamam on 5 December 2024 to discuss the suggestions from the Presbyteral Council held on 31 July 2024 and to conduct a self-evaluation of priests. The conference began with an hour of Adoration, led by Rev. Fr. Toji Parambilparambil. Following a short break, the conference officially commenced at 11:00 am. Rev. Fr. Vicar General extended a warm welcome to all, and Rev. Bishop presided over the meeting. A special group discussion was organized, moderated by Rev. Fr. Mathew Kuzhinjalil and Rev. Fr. Justin Cheruvelil, the Presbyterium Secretary. Rev. Fr. Mathew Kuzhinjalil introduced the theme, while Rev. Fr. Justin Cheruvelil presented the points raised

during the Presbyteral Council. The main topic of discussion was "Concerns, Challenges, and Preoccupations of Priests Regarding Their Life and Ministry in the Diocese of Thuckalay." The priests were divided into three groups for discussion, with questions distributed to guide the conversation. The group discussions lasted for approximately 45 minutes. In the second half of the meeting, Rev. Fr. Thomas Sathianesan presented a detailed diocesan action plan for the Christ Jubilee 2025. Representatives from the three groups then shared their findings in a common session. This was the first time the priests convened to discuss and collectively address current issues.


