Message

Dear Friends and Benefactors, Greetings from the Diocese of Thuckalay!

We are going to celebrate Mission Sunday on 20 October. It is an occasion to pray for the missions, to contribute financially to missionary works, and above all, an opportunity to review our own attitude toward the evangelizing mission of the Church and reaffirm our commitment to furthering the missionary mandate of Jesus Christ. The Holy Father invites us to consider the missio ad gentes as a great and immense work of mercy, both spiritual and material. On this World Mission Sunday, we are all invited to "go out" as missionary disciples, each generously offering their talents, creativity, wisdom, and experience to bring the message of God's tenderness and compassion to the entire human family. By virtue of the missionary mandate, the Church cares for those who do not know the Gospel, because she wants everyone to be saved and to experience the Lord's love. She "is commissioned to announce the mercy of God, the beating heart of the Gospel" (Misericordiae Vultus, 12) and to proclaim mercy in every corner of the world, reaching every person, young or old.

The Holy Father invites everyone—priests, religious, and lay people—to engage in the evangelizing mission of the Church. He provides the reason for the Church's

missionary activities, writing: "All peoples and cultures have the right to receive the message of salvation, which is God's gift to every person. This is all the more necessary when we consider how many injustices, wars, and humanitarian crises still need resolution. Missionaries know from experience that the Gospel of forgiveness and mercy can bring joy and reconciliation, justice and peace." The Gospel's mandate to "go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20) has not ceased. Rather, this command commits all of us, amid the current landscape with all its challenges, to hear the call to a renewed missionary "impulse," as I noted in my Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium: "Each Christian and every community must discern the path that the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey His call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the 'peripheries' in need of the light of the Gospel" (20).

I earnestly invite all of you, dear friends, to proclaim Jesus Christ in season and out of season to our people, not only in our own settings but even by going to the peripheries, as Pope Francis invites us to do. We need to have the fire and intense desire for Jesus Christ, which can come only from a genuine personal experience of the Master. May this Mission Sunday that we are celebrating continue to be a moment of rededication to our Christian call. The diocese is marching forward with this command of Jesus to proclaim. I thank you for being a source of strength in the missionary activities of the diocese through your financial support and prayers.



Priests' Assembly at Kalluvilai

The monthly Priests' Conference was held at Kalluvilai on September 3, 2024, commencing at 9:30 AM. The day began with a period of adoration led by Fr. Lijo Thekkel, followed by confessions, which established a prayerful atmosphere. Official proceedings began at 11:15 AM, with Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, the Chancellor, coordinating in the absence of the Vicar General, and Bishop Mar George Rajendran presiding over the conference. A warm welcome was extended to Rev. Fr. Thomas Kaniirakkatt, the Mission Coordinator of the Cumbum-Theni Missions, attending for the first time, along with Fr. Prince Maliyil and Fr. Shoji Puthenpurackal, who were visiting from Ireland. Special appreciation was expressed to Fr. Mathew Kuzhinjalil for his generous donation of land for the TPWA project in Kumarakovil.

Following introductions, department heads and association leaders provided updates on upcoming events, while Mission Coordinators shared their experiences and developments from various mission stations. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal presented a summary of the Fifth Major Archiepiscopal Assembly, accompanied by a video presentation. In his address, Bishop Mar George Rajendran discussed recent Synodal developments and the expectations set forth by the Synodal Fathers regarding the life and ministry of priests. The conference concluded with a festive Onam Sadhya at Aseer Auditorium, Kalluvilai, marking a successful gathering enriched by the active participation and meaningful contributions of all attendees.

ASMI Congregation's 50th Year Celebration

The Apostolic Sisters of Mary Immaculate (ASMI) celebrated the Golden Jubilee of their congregation on September 21, 2024, at their Generalate House in Cheeranchira, Changanacherry. Founded by Cardinal Mar Antony Padiyara on September 21, 1974, the congregation currently comprises 100 sisters actively engaged in various ministries. The ASMI Sisters began their mission in the Kanyakumari region on January 26, 1978, providing exceptional service in the parishes of Nithiravilai, Annikkarai, Vayalinkarai, and Cheenivilai. Their dedicated work at Karunayillam is particularly commendable, focusing on serving the mentally and physically differently-abled, offering

palliative care, social services, conducting house visits, and providing counseling support.

The Thanksgiving Holy Qurbana commenced at 3:30 PM, with Mar Joseph Perumthottam as the main celebrant and Bishop Mar George Rajendran concelebrating alongside him. Following the Mass, a public Jubilee meeting was held, presided over by the Bishop. In his presidential address, he expressed the gratitude of the diocese to the Superior General, Rev. Sr. Mercy Maria ASMI, and to the entire congregation for their invaluable contributions to the diocese and the Church at large.







Bringing Health to the Heart:Medical Camps by the Health Commission

The Health Commission, in collaboration with Helson Healthcare, conducted a free medical camp at the Mukkoottukal Holy Family Church campus on September 29, 2024, benefiting 75 individuals. Additionally, on the same day, the Health Commission organized an awareness camp in Vayalinkarai that focused on addiction and parenting. Led by Fr. Subin, Director of the Health Commission, the session attracted 25 mothers from the parish, fostering a supportive community and empowering them with valuable insights.

Earlier, on September 3, 2024, the Health Commission, in partnership with the Changing

the Way We Care (CTWWC) team from Kanyakumari Social Service Society (KKSSS), organized a parents-teachers awareness meeting at Karunalayam, Kalluvalai, a school dedicated to the care and education of children with intellectual disabilities. The session witnessed active participation from 33 parents and 11 teachers, all eager to enhance their understanding of child-rearing in the context of mental health and family values. These initiatives underscore the Health Commission's commitment to promoting health and well-being within the community.





Voices of Tomorrow: SMYM Forane and Central Elections 2024-2025

The Forane and Central elections for SMYM leaders took place in September 2024. The Arukani Forane election was held on September 1, followed by the Kaliyal Forane election at Marappady on September 8. Wellness on Wheels: A Day of Care in TN Kulam

On August 31, 2023, a successful medical camp was organized in TN Kulam by the Himadri Ayurveda Doctors, providing much-needed healthcare services to the local community. The event aimed to offer free medical check-ups and assistance to those who may not have regular access to healthcare. A total of 230 patients received free consultations, including health screenings and personalized health advice, highlighting the importance of preventive care. The doctors also conducted health awareness sessions, educating participants about maintaining a healthy lifestyle through nutrition and stress management. Additionally, the camp distributed essential medical supplies, including




